Artwork drop-off, exhibition, community art project and artwork pick up will take place at The Building for Kids, 100 W College Ave, Appleton, WI 54911. Artwork may be dropped off at the front desk of The Building for Kids no later than 5 pm on December 16th to be included in the exhibit. Submitters should be aware that artwork will be mounted to construction paper matting.

Terms of Entry:

The Building for Kids has the right to refuse any work it deems inappropriate and that does not match submission guidelines. Work must be:

- 2-dimensional artwork on paper (up to 3 pieces)
- No larger than 11x14
- · Created by persons age 16 and under
- · Labeled on the back in the following format:
 - Artist's Name
 - Age
 - Title
 - Media
 - Parent's Name
 - · Contact information

I understand that the BFK will make every effort to maintain the condition of the art submitted, but do not hold them liable for damage. I give the BFK permission to exhibit and photograph the artwork submitted. I accept the rules, dates, and terms listed above.
