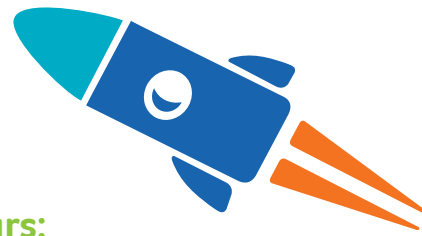
Children's Parade

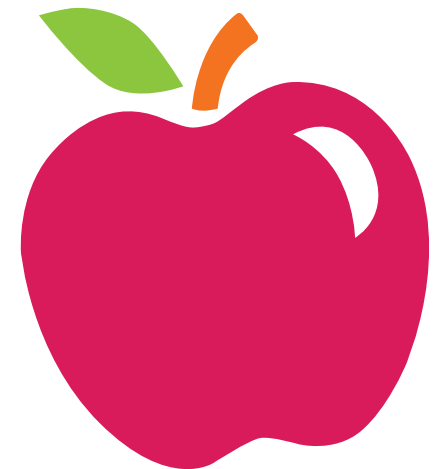
